New Book Provides Roadmap for the Journey to Leadership Maturity

Hundreds of millions of dollars are spent on leadership development each year. Yet young professionals are not learning how to become mature, evolved leaders. Marshall developed her groundbreaking approach to leadership by studying and conversing with fifty leaders in diverse fields of organizational and personal change—from CEOs to school superintendents, dance troupe founders and decorated military officers to nonprofit-organization directors and government officials, judges to street-gang leaders—to understand the mature leader's journey and identify useful tools and strategies for navigating it.
